Supplies to bring/wear each day:

Face Mask for covid-19 safety

Shoes that can be taken on and off independently and are comfortable for running and climbing

Water bottle

Lunch (will be stored outdoors in the shade, so please include an ice pack if needed)

Sun hat

Sunscreen (already applied)

**Much of our day will be spent in the shade, but we know how powerful the sun is here!*

Picnic blanket/sheet/tablecloth that can go on the ground (these can stay at camp all week and will be our spaced-out seating method for snacks and lunch time).

For readers, a book (we will encourage quiet reading after lunch, though listening to a story will also be an option)

Supplies to NOT bring/wear each day:

Clothing that is delicate or must remain clean

Toys from home unless needed for comfort or requested for a specific activity

Drop-off/Pick-up

Please drop off your child/ren fed and dressed appropriately for the range of weather the day may offer between 8:50 and 9:05 a.m. For everyone's safety, please approach and depart slowly in your vehicle. Pick up is promptly between 2:50 and 3:05 unless you have enrolled in after-care.

Fees Policy

Tuition is to be paid in full for all June camps by May 21st, 2021 and for all July camps by June 15th, 2021. Cancellation and date change before May 21st carries a \$25/week processing fee, cancellation up to 7 days in advance carries \$100/week processing fee. After the deadlines specified, Reunity will not offer any refund except in Reunity's sole discretion in the case of a verified family emergency, including probable or confirmed covid exposure. We appreciate your understanding that your registration is a commitment and fees cover camp staff and supplies.

In the event Reunity cannot operate the camps as planned due to weather conditions, effects of a pandemic, illness, government orders, war, terrorist attacks, or other serious or unforeseen circumstances, Reunity will provide a refund of fees to the extent the closure caused by such events or circumstances exceeds 3 days.

Credit/debit card and check made out to Reunity Resources are both acceptable forms of payment.

Rights and Responsibilities

Our fundamental priority in Farm Camp is to create a community of care: for ourselves, for one another, and for the plants and earth that sustain us. All attendees are expected to use respectful language, participate in group activities in a harmonious manner, communicate their wants and needs productively, and be responsive to instructions and guidelines.

If a challenge or conflict arises that the children cannot resolve on their own, various techniques will be used including:

- Change of environment/stimulation
- Opportunity for snack, rest or a quiet activity
- Guidance by an instructor/administrator through conversation
- Guidance to a different area to work/play alongside an instructor/administrator

If a behavioral challenge persists beyond these supports, we will communicate with parents/guardians to discuss other ideas. If we are unable to resolve persistent behavioral issues, Reunity reserves the right to temporarily suspend and/or dismiss the child from the program.

Waiver and Indemnification

I, a parent or guardian of a minor participant, hereby agree to release and not to sue, and to indemnify (including to defend against and pay claims and costs including attorney's fees and insurance deductibles) Reunity Resources, its directors, officers, staff and contractors ("released parties") from all claims of injury or loss to me or to the minor child, in any way arising out of my, or the minor child's, participation in an activity of Reunity Resources, or being on the premises of the Center or another activity site, whether caused by negligence, breach of contract or otherwise, and including bodily injury, death, property damage or other loss.

I represent that I have for my child/ren, adequate insurance to cover any injury or damage the child/ren may cause or suffer while participating in a Reunity Resources activity or moving about the premises of Reunity Resources or adjacent activity sites. In any event, I agree to bear the costs of such injury or damage as set forth in this Agreement.

I agree that any dispute between a Released Party and a participant or Parent will be governed by the substantive laws of the State of New Mexico.

COVID-19 SAFETY INFORMATION

Reunity Resources will make every effort to ensure a safe environment for all camp participants that reduces exposure to the covid-19 virus. We will follow all State guidelines of group sizes, mandatory quarantine around out-of-state travel, and CDC recommendations.

We want to create a culture of mutual protection. The core elements of this culture will be:

- Masks – wearing masks over mouth and nose at all times except when eating or drinking
 - If you or your child does not have a mask, we will provide you/them with one
- Hygiene – frequent, regular hand-washing and sanitizing; frequent cleaning of frequently touched surfaces
 - Do not touch your face, eyes, nose, mouth with unwashed hands
 - We will provide hand sanitizer and cleaning supplies
 - Our farm surface sanitizer is called Sani-Date and is hydrogen peroxide based
- Distancing – interacting with others in an outdoor (ideal) or well-ventilated area; maintaining at least 6 feet distance from other people when masks are off for eating/drinking (3 feet is currently recommended in elementary school settings); following group size limitations
- Screening – staying home while sick

Before attending Farm Camp, please conduct the following evaluation for your child/ren:

- Have they or anyone in your household had probable exposure to COVID in the last week? If yes, please plan to keep your child at home and contact Juliana.
- If today, or in the past 24 hours, have they had any of the following symptoms, please plan to keep your child at home and contact Juliana:
 - Fever
 - New onset cough
 - New onset shortness of breath or difficulty breathing
 - New loss of taste or smell
 - Sore throat
 - More physical exhaustion than normal (fatigue)
 - Unexplained muscle or body aches
 - Chills (repeated shaking)
 - New onset or unusual headache
 - New onset nasal congestion or runny nose
 - Nausea or vomiting
 - Diarrhea

By signing below, I acknowledge that I will perform this screening each day before dropping off my child/ren. If the answer to any of these questions is yes, I will notify Juliana Ciano (juliana@reunityresources.com or 505-428-8330) and keep my child/ren home until a negative covid test can be obtained or whatever the CDC recommends at the time.

In the unlikely event of a probable exposure among campers, all participants with potential contact will be informed and asked to take covid-19 tests and receive a negative result before returning to camp. There are abundant rapid and free testing options available (you can even order an at-home saliva test for free from Vault Health online for a non-invasive option).
